

In the matter of the petition of Joseph Miles
and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road, the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway fifty (50) feet in width. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of Jonathan Cleaver
and others for the establishment of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read and the board being of opinion that the compensation awarded to wit: To John D. Boshe Forty dollars compensation for land should not be allowed the said claim and award is disallowed, and no legal objections being made to the report the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of said viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway forty (40) feet in width. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of M. S. Beach
and others for a change in county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said proposed change the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said change of road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey of said change of road be recorded and that said change of road be established (60) sixty feet in width. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.
