The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was publicly read and the board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by said viewers to wit: L. Hardwick's \$100. compensation and O. Paul \$100. compensation ~~is~~ ^{is} just with the exception that the amount awarded O. Paul is \$50. too much. It is ordered that the County Clerk draw order upon the County Treasurer for \$100. in favor of L. Hardwick and \$50. in favor of O. Paul and the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established as put in writing. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of E. G. Macy and others for the vacation of a county road.

The viewers having reported in favor of the vacation of said road the report was read and on motion ordered that the further consideration of the report be postponed until the next regular session of the board.
