

the County Superintendent also being present the parties were heard when it was ordered that the decision of the Superintendent be affirmed and sustained.

A petition was presented signed by W.R. Davis and thirty seven other citizens of Palmyra Township asking that an appropriation of One hundred and twenty five dollars be made to build a bridge across Hagues crute on the road leading from Baldwin City to Ottawa. Ordered that the sum of One hundred Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of building a bridge over Hagues crute on the Baldwin City and Ottawa road.

It is further ordered that the Trustee of Palmyra Township be authorized to build said bridge and present account to this board with vouchers.

A petition was presented signed by S.E. Whitney and other free holders of Grant Township, asking that the board cause a bridge to be built over Muddy crute at a point where a county road crosses said crute on the section line between Sections 16 and 21 town 12 range 20. Ordered that A.G. Norman Trustee of Grant Township do and he hereby is appointed a Commissioner to advertise for proposals for building a bridge at the aforementioned point at a cost of not to exceed One thousand Dollars, according to plans and specifications prepared by Holland Whelan County Surveyor.

A petition was presented signed by John Doaks and other residents of Palmyra Township asking the board to make an appropriation of One hundred and twenty five dollars (\$125.00) for the purpose of improving the road known as Baysingus lane at the crossing of Ottawa crute. Ordered that the township trustee of Palmyra Township do and he is hereby authorized to expend the sum of One hundred dollars on the road known as Baysingus lane at the crossing of Ottawa crute and present his account with vouchers to this board. The sum of \$100. is hereby appropriated for said purpose.

J. J. Starr Comum of Poor of Palmyra Township presented an application for an appropriation of \$100. for temporary relief of poor in said township. Ordered that an appropriation of One hundred dollars be, and is hereby, made for support of poor in Palmyra Township. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue an order to the County Treasurer for \$100. in favor of the Comum of poor of Palmyra Township.

A Donor presented a petition asking that certain lots in the town of Aurora be released from taxes. Ordered that said petition be laid over for consideration at some future meeting of the board.
