

of the cost of a bridge over Washington Creek on the line between Section fifteen (15) and twenty two (22) town thirteen (13) South of range nineteen (19) East. Also an estimate of the expense of making road leading to the bridge from the East. The report was read and ordered filed.

A copy of the report of the judge and county attorney on the condition of the county jail, made at the August term of the District court in and for the county of Douglas was presented read and ordered filed.

In the matter of the petition of John Gilmore and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read and the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners to wit: To John L. Haskell one hundred and fifty dollars compensation, To J. J. Melshie ninety dollars compensation and one hundred dollars damages, is reasonable and just, and that L. Wootch, although having made no claim for compensation, to the viewers, is justly entitled to three hundred dollars compensation for land and that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the county treasury. It is ordered, that the county clerk draw orders upon the county treasurer, in favor of John L. Haskell for one hundred and fifty dollars, in favor of J. J. Melshie for one hundred and ninety dollars, and in favor of L. Wootch for three hundred dollars, It is further ordered, that the several reports of the viewers, with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway sixty (60) feet in width. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseers of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the report of Commissioners appointed by the Legislature to locate a State road

Commissioners appointed by an act of the legislature of the State of Kansas approved March 3^d 1870 having reported their proceedings under said appointment the report was this day publicly read, and said Commissioners having recommended that compensation and damages be awarded as follows to wit: To Daniel Phoenix Three hundred dollars damages To Charles Bootholz One hundred and sixty six Dollars sixty two and one half cents, To John Kirby One hundred and fifty dollars, damages and the board being of opinion that said damages so recommended are excessive and unjust, It is Ordered that compensation for land be allowed said parties as follows to wit: To Daniel Phoenix one hundred dollars, To C. Bootholz thirty three dollars and thirty three cents (\$33.33) and it is further Ordered that the county clerk issue warrants on the Treasurer for the amounts so allowed in favor of said parties. It is further ordered that the sum of five
