The board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Joel Grove, J. C. Jones and W. Winshaw and Paul R. Brooks county clerk. The following proceedings were had:

In the matter of the petition of David Robinson
and others for the establishment of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the road, the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made, nor damages claimed. The board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered, that the report of said viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petition of James H. Kelley
and others for the establishment of a county road.

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road said report was this day publicly read and no legal objection being made, nor damages claimed. The board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered, that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petition of C. Beotholy and others
for a change in a State road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said change of road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have agreed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also publicly read and the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said viewers to wit: To Margaret Schleifer, forty Dollars compensation and one hundred dollars damages, is not just and reasonable, it is ordered that Ninety five dollars be allowed to Margaret Schleifer for compensation for land, and it is further ordered that the several reports of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded, that said change be established according to law. It is further
