The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road said report was this day publicly read and said viewers having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also publicly read, and the board being of opinion that the award of said viewers on the claims of H. B. Leacy and Charles Wilson is unjust. It is ordered that the sum of twenty five dollars be allowed H. B. Leacy as compensation for said road and that the sum of ten dollars be allowed Charles Wilson as compensation and said road being in the opinion of the board of public utility. It is ordered that the several reports of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.
