It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper officers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of A. B. Martin and others for the establishment of a road.

The petitioners having made application for road as follows beginning at the South East corner of Section Seventeen (17) Town Fifteen (15) Range Eighteen (18) Thence North Nine miles to the North East corner of Section five (5) town and range aforesaid, and A. B. Martin one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of \$200. payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is hereby accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve (12) householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that Henry Webb, J. C. Mitchell and Thomas Banks do and they hereby are appointed review and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road, and that said review and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the first day of March 1871 and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said review and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Wm. Fox and others for the establishment of a road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at the North East corner of the North West quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Town Twelve (12) Range Seventeen (17) running South on the half section line three (3) miles to the Deer creek road near the South West corner of the South East quarter of Section Twenty six (26) Township Twelve (12) Range Seventeen (17) or as near on said line as practicable, and William Fox one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve (12) householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that William H. Christian, James M. Beach and William Fitzpatrick do and they hereby are appointed review and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition, on the seventh (7th) day of February A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue, in the name of the board the necessary order to said review and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Henry Piper and others asking for the establishment of a road.

Said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning at the North West corner of Section Twenty six (26) Township Twelve (12) Range Seventeen (17) Thence running four (4) miles East, to the North East corner of Section Twenty nine (29) Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18) or as near said line as practicable and Henry Piper
