

one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that William H. Christian, J. M. Beach and William Fitzpatrick be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the seventh day of February A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of F. W. Cosgrove and others for the establishment of a road in Douglas county

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at the South West corner of the South East quarter of Section eighteen (18) Township Thirteen Range eighteen (18) Thence Westward as near as practicable on the section line until it intersects the Eastern line of Shawnee County, and Thence Northward one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that B. L. Stettin, J. M. Radlock and Geo. W. Warringer be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 7th day of March 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of F. Gleason and others for change and vacation of road

The petitioners have made application for a change of road and for the vacation of a road as follows, That a change be made in the State road leading from Topeka to Ottawa, beginning at the centre of Section fourteen (14) Township fifteen (15) Range eighteen (18) and thence vacating all of said road to a point where it crosses the half section line dividing Section three (3) said township and range and that said road be located as follows beginning at the centre of said Section fourteen (14) Thence North on half section line to the North line of said Section fourteen (14) Thence West one mile to intersect a North and South road, Thence North to where said State road now crosses the half section line in Section three (3) above said. Also that a part of a road beginning at the South line of Douglas County, at a point on the section line between Sections 13 and 14 town 15 range 18 and running North on section lines be vacated as follows beginning at the county line, thence North vacate one mile, and F. Gleason one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it
