The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning at a point in the Lawrence and Emporia road where said road crosses the section line dividing sections twenty one (21) and twenty two (22) town 13 range 18 thence South on section lines as near as practicable to the South West corner of section ten (10) township fourteen (14) range eighteen (18) thence West eighty (80) rods thence South to the South line of section 33 town 14 range 18 and S. A. Waldeman one of the petitioners one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that E. In the matter of the petition of W. W. Bates and others for the establishment of a road

W. Bates one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that W. W. Sharr, W. B. Norman and Joseph Barrett be and they hereby are appointed viewers, and Holland Whelan surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 21st day of February A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers.
