

In the matter of the petition of E. B. Macy
and others for the alteration of a road.

The petitioners having made application for a change of road as follows a portion of the county road that is located between the South West quarter of Section thirteen (13) and South East quarter of Section fourteen (14) Township thirteen (13) range eighteen (18) all that portion of said road that diverges from the line between the two named quarters of land running North Westward and then back to the line, we do hereby make void and located on the said line, and E. B. Macy one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that Presley King, E. W. Cloud and Gabriel Markle be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said change of road and that the said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 14th day of February A.D. 1871 it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Presley King and others
for the establishment of a ^{change of} road in Douglas county.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning at the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section eight (8) town thirteen (13) range nineteen (19) thence West on the middle line of said section to the North West corner of the South West quarter of said section and cause all that portion of road that now runs through said section in a diagonal direction to be null and void and Presley King one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of one hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that William Brown, E. P. Briggs and George Gilbert be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 16th day of February A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the assessment of
J. C. Crane with personal property.

Said J. C. Crane having presented evidence satisfactory to the board that on the first day of March A.D. 1870 he was the owner of no personal property subject to taxation. It is ordered that the tax on personal property assessed to said J. C. Crane for the year 1870 be and the same is hereby cancelled.
