The board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Brown, Jones and Henshaw and Paul R. Brooks County clerk. The following proceedings were had.

James Walter Superintendent of the County Asylum presented his report of the affairs of the asylum for the year 1870 including cash account which was examined by the board and accepted.

Ordered that the county clerk be and he is hereby instructed to advertise for sealed proposals for doing the county printing and advertising for one year from the 14th day of February A.D. 1871 bids to be received until February 12th 1871 at ten o'clock a.m.

Ordered that the county clerk be and he hereby is instructed to advertise for proposals for superintending the County Asylum for one year from the first day of March A.D. 1871

In the matter of the claim of Rachel Madden for damages on account of ditch in road

The said Rachel Madden having filed a claim for damages on account of a ditch having been constructed by the County in the road adjoining her land - Ordered that the claim be disallowed.

The board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock
