The board of county commissioners met pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners, Brown, Jones and Kershaw, and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk. The following proceedings were had.

The board proceeded to open and examine proposals for Superintending the County Asylum and farm. The bid of Nyle Service being considered the best and most advantageous for the County. It is ordered that the bid of said Nyle Service be and the same is hereby accepted. It is further ordered that Nyle Service be and he hereby is appointed Superintendent of the County Asylum for one year from the first day of March A.D. 1871 at a salary of seven hundred dollars per annum.

The board proceeded to open and examine proposals for doing the county printing and advertising for one year from the first day of April A.D. 1871. And the bid of T. D. Thacher being considered the lowest and best bid. It is ordered that the contract for the county printing be awarded to said T. D. Thacher for one year from the first day of April A.D. 1871 in accordance with the following proposal on which this award is made.
