The board of commissioners met pursuant to adjournment these were present Commissioners Joel Brown chairman of the board J. H. Jones and Austin Keimshaw and Paul R. Brooks county clerk

The following proceedings were had.

The board proceeded to open and examine bids for furnishing medical services at the County Asylum and County jail and Wilder and Moore being the only bidders. It is ordered that the contract be awarded to said Wilder and Moore at the following rates to wit: Three (\$3) dollars for each visit to the County Asylum and One (1) dollar for each visit to the jail.

In the matter of the special election ordered to be called on the 4th day of April A.D. 1871

Ordered that the action of the board had on the 14th day of February in regard to a special election be reconsidered.

Ordered that a special election be held on the 4th day of April A.D. 1871 at the usual places of holding elections in the several voting precincts of the county for the purpose of voting upon the following proposition to wit: Shall the board of commissioners of the county of Douglas be authorized to issue the bonds of the county to the amount of fifty three thousand dollars payable thirty years from date with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, payable annually on the first day of July in the city of New York and to use the proceeds of the sale of said bonds for the following purposes to wit: For aiding the city of Lawrence in building or procuring a bridge across the Kansas River at the city of Lawrence the proceeds of thirty thousand dollars in bonds. and for building bridges at the following named points to wit: One over Captain Creek on the Lawrence and Olathe road, One over Deer Creek on section line between sections four (4) and nine (9) One over the Wakarusa river at a point on or near the section line between sections sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) Township thirteen (13) range nineteen (19) One over the Wakarusa river on the State road leading West from Clinton, the proceeds of twenty three thousand dollars, provided that said bonds shall not be sold or negotiated at less than ninety five cents on the dollar. Vouchers to be written or printed "for the bonds" or against the bonds.
