

Lawrence Kansas April 11 1891

The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment.
There were present commissioners Brown, Jones and Keishaw, and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.
The following proceedings were had

In the matter of the petition of James Southam
and others for the establishment of a road

The referees having filed their report it was read
and in the opinion of the board said report being illegal It is Ordered that the petition be dis-
missed at the cost of the County of Douglas.

In the matter of the petition of Thomas Rayson
and others for the establishment of a road

Said petitioners having made application for the estab-
lishment of a road as follows.

Beginning at the East line of Douglas county between Sections Twenty two (22),
and Twenty three (23) Township Thirteen 13 Range twenty one (21). Thence running West Six miles and
connecting with a laid road West of Sections Twenty three (23) and Twenty six (26) township Thirteen (13)
Range twenty (20) or as near said line as practicable. and Thomas Rayson one of the petitioners hav-
ing filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use
of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said
application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted And it appearing that said petition
is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of
the petition has been given as required by law It is Ordered that John Wilder, John Brown
and S. W. Warren do and they hereby are appointed referees and T. C. Darling Surveyor, and that said
referees and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 6th day of
May A.D. 1891 and having been duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appoint-
ments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board
the necessary order to said referees and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of D. L. Barkell and
others for the establishment of a road

Said petitioners having made application for the es-
tablishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South West corner of Section thirty two (32) Township
Twelve (12) Range twenty (20) Thence North one half mile on the Section line to the North West cor-
ner of the South West quarter of said Section thirty two (32) and D. L. Barkell one of the petitioners
having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the
county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application
in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and it appearing that notice of the presentation of
the petition has been given as required by law and that the petition is signed by at least twelve house
holders of said county of Douglas. It is ordered that Geo. W. Goss, Charles Longfellow and Samuel Reynolds
do and they are hereby appointed referees and T. C. Darling Surveyor and that said referees and
surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 26th day of April A.D. 1891 at
ten o'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several ap-
pointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name
of the board the necessary order to said referees and surveyor.
