

In the matter of the petition of Robert
Fultz and others for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the North West corner of Section thirty five (35) township twelve (12) range seventeen (17) thence South on the county line between Douglas and Shawnee counties to the South West corner of Section two (2) township thirteen (13) Range seventeen (17) and Robert Fultz one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that William M. Ware Robert Young and James M. Beach be and they hereby are appointed viewers and F. C. Darling Surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of E. D. Leadd
and others for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at a point in the South boundary line of the city of Lawrence at the center of Vermont Street thence South to the South line of the North West quarter of Section seven (7) Township thirteen (13) Range twenty (20) thence East along said line to the South East corner of said quarter section thence North to the North East corner of said quarter section. And E. D. Leadd one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law it is ordered that William Brown William Smithfield and William Savage be and they are hereby appointed viewers and F. C. Darling Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 21st day of April and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.
