

to said William McKinney a license to keep and run a ferry on the Kansas river at the town of Leecompton for one year from the first day of April 1871 upon his filing a bond according to law.

In the matter of the petition of Oscar Richards and others for license for A. Cohen to keep a Ferry.

Said petitioners having made application for a license to keep a ferry for A. Cohen, to be kept and run on the Kansas river at the town of Eudora. The board being of opinion that such ferry is necessary for the accommodation of the public. It is ordered that the county clerk issue a license to said A. Cohen to keep and run a ferry on the Kansas river at the town of Eudora for one year from the first day of April 1871 upon his filing a bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, as required by law.

The reports of A. B. Norman trustee of Grant Township, William Means trustee of Wakarusa Township, Robert Heying trustee of Leecompton Township, S. B. Darling trustee of Eudora Township, J. C. Vincent trustee of Kawaska Township, and J. D. Starn trustee of Palmyra Township for the past year were examined with vouchers and approved.

In the matter of the petition of David Griffith and others for the alteration of a State road.

The petitioners having made application for a change in the State road leading South West from Wyandotte as follows. Beginning at a point in said road forty three (43) rods West of the North East corner of the South East quarter of section seven (7) town fifteen (15) range twenty (20) thence vacate all of said road to the West line of said section seven (7) and that said road be located as follows beginning as above thence westerly along the route of the road now travelled to the bridge across Middle Ottawa creek thence along said travelled road to the half section line dividing the North West and South West quarters of said section seven (7) thence West on said half section line to the West line of said section seven (7) and David Griffith one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted. Which bond is hereby accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that S. B. Black, S. B. Rodwell and S. B. Black be and they hereby are appointed viewers and S. B. Darling Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the first day of May 1871 at 10 o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of E. E. Louis and others for the establishment of a road.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Begin at the North East corner of section six (6) Township thirteen (13) range twenty (20) and running due West along the North line of said section to the East side of Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence in said County and E. E. Louis one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas. conditioned for the payment
