

of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least fifteen householders of said county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that S. W. Hoss, Samuel Reynolds and Charles Strongfellow be and they being are appointed viewers and S. B. Darling Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 20th day of April A.D. 1871 at ten o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of G. W. Gates
and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having made a separate report in writing in regard to compensation and damages said report was also read and on motion Ordered that the consideration of the reports and action thereon be postponed until April 17th 1871

In the matter of the petition of S. M. Reynolds
and others for the establishment ^{of a change} of a road.

Said petitioners having made application for the alteration of a state road and said petition having been read at the January meeting of the board and laid over it was again considered and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that a majority of the resident owners of the real estate adjoining the portion of road proposed to be changed had not signed it is ordered that said petition be dismissed without further proceedings

In the matter of the petition of Henry Pifer
and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read. On motion Ordered that action on the report be postponed until the July meeting of the board 1871

J. T. Starr Queen of poor of Palmyra Township presented an application asking for an appropriation for support of poor in said township.

Ordered that the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the county general fund for temporary support of poor in the township of Palmyra and further ordered that the county clerk issue an order on the Treasurer for said amount payable to the Queen of Poor in and for said township.
