

Notice of Appeal and bond filed in County Clerk's Office April 17th 1891

It is ordered that the County Clerk cancel said warrants on the record of orders issued as required by law.

In the matter of the petition of S. A. Halderman and others
For the location and establishment of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said viewers having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to the several land owners on account of the location of said road through their premises said report was also publicly read and their being in the opinion of the Board no legal claims for compensation and damages the report of the viewers being favorable to the establishment of the road and the Board being of opinion that said road as located and changed will be of public utility it is ordered that the reports of the viewers with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established.

It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the Board to the proper owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of Charles Kaufman and others for the establishment of a road.

Said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road, and the description being imperfect. Ordered that action on the petition be postponed until the 19th April 1891.

In the matter of the petition of Thomas W. Nail
For taxes to be refunded on property in Lawrence

Said petitioner having made application to have taxes refunded on property occupied as residence for the Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in Kansas. And the matter having been referred to the County Attorney and said County Attorney having submitted an opinion that said property was not exempt under the law from taxation. It is ordered that the petition be dismissed without further proceedings.
