Lawrence Kansas April 19th 1871

The board of county commissioners met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Brown, Jones and Hinchaw and Paul R. Brooks County clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the petition of Chas. E. Kaufman for the location and establishment of a road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the county line between the County of Douglas and Leavenworth where the road from Leavenworth to Lawrence crosses said line thence in a South westerly direction until it intersects the road running from Lawrence to Hixsonville and Charles E. Kaufman one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition is not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law it is ordered that A. B. Norman, J. C. Bennett and J. B. Morgan be and they hereby are appointed viewers and J. L. Darling Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper officers of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.
