

half of the South East quarter of Section six (6) Township thirteen (13) Range twenty one (21) Thence North on the section line to intersection with the Lawrence and Cuda road. Also begin at the South West corner of the South East quarter of Section six (6) town and range aforesaid, Thence West on Section line one half mile to intersection with road running North and South, and Dr. J. Sperry one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of five hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses concerning upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved. and it appearing that petition is signed by at least twelve householders of county of Douglas and it appearing that notice of the petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that Fitch Read W. B. Kennedy and C. L. Ladd be and they hereby are appointed Viewers and J. C. Darling surveyor and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place appointed in said petition as the place of beginning on the 3rd day of May A.D. 1871 at ten o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of L. W. Bates
and others for the establishment of a road.

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road and said report having been read at the meeting of the board April 5th and action on said report having been postponed until the 19th April The report was again read and said viewers having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have awarded to land owners by reason of the location of the road through their several premises said report was also publicly read and the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said viewers to the several claimants to wit

To J. E. Morgan Forty Dollars compensation and one hundred and fifteen dollars damages

To Mary J. Whitney Twenty five dollars compensation

is excessive It is ordered that J. E. Morgan be allowed the sum of one hundred and thirty five dollars compensation and damages and that no compensation or damages be allowed to Mary J. Whitney and the board being further of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of sufficient importance and public utility to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the county treasury it is ordered that the County clerk draw a warrant on the County treasury for the sum of \$135. in favor of J. E. Morgan. and that the several reports of the viewers with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads adjoining same to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the application of H. B. Leacy for
an appropriation for support of Martha Ann Leacy

The said H. B. Leacy having made application for an appropriation of \$250. to enable him to procure medical treatment for Martha Ann Leacy a pauper of Kearns town-
ship

Ordered that the sum of \$250. be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the County general fund for the support and medical treatment of said Martha Ann Leacy for one year from the first day of May 1871. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue a warrant on the County treasury payable to said H. B. Leacy wherein said Leacy shall file a bond in the sum of \$500. with sureties to be approved by said clerk conditioned that said Martha Ann Leacy shall be supported for one year from the first day of May 1871 without any further cost or expense to the County of Douglas.
