

Tuesday July 11 1871

The Board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Grover Jones and Hinchman, and Paul R. Brooks county clerk. The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the petition of H. M. Simpson
and others for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for a road as follows Beginning at a point eighty (80) rods North of the South East corner of the North West quarter of Section number six (6) Township Thirteen (13) S. Range Twenty (20) East of fifth (5) principal Meridian thence East to Dunning Street or his hundred and forty one (141) feet more or less. and H. M. Simpson one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred (200) dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted, which bond is hereby accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve (12) householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that H. W. E. D. Sodd and Charles Longfellow be and they hereby are appointed viewers and T. L. Darling surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the seventh day of August A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of R. W. Lendington
and others for the establishment of a county road.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section one (1) Township Thirteen (13) Range Nineteen (19) thence North to a point forty (40) rods South of the North East corner of the North East quarter of said Section one (1) thence West twenty (20) rods to the East line of the State University grounds. And R. W. Lendington one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve (12) householders of said county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that H. W. E. D. Sodd and Charles Longfellow be and they hereby are appointed viewers and T. L. Darling surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition ^{on the seventh day of August A.D. 1871} and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.

In the matter of the petition of M. E. Beach
and others for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at a point nine (9) chains and twenty five (25) links North of the South East corner of the North West quarter of Section Twenty five (25) Township twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) thence West parallel with the South boundary of said quarter Section forty (40) chains to the West boundary of said quarter section Also beginning at the South East corner of the North West quarter of Section Twenty five (25) Township twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) and running North eighty (80) rods to the North boundary of West Lawrence.
