

to widen Michigan Street between said points to the width of eighty (80) feet. And Mr. B. Brack one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of said county and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that George Hilbert, E. P. Briggs and William Brown be and they hereby are appointed viewers and locating surveyors of said road and that said viewers and surveyors meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 8th day of August A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyors.

In the matter of the petition of William Milner and others for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. beginning at the Section corner between Sections eight (8) and nine (9) Tenth (10) and eleventh (11) town twelve (12) range twenty (20) and running thence North as near as practicable on the section line between Sections four (4), five (5) eight (8) and nine (9) town and range as above to the North line of Douglas County, two miles. And William Milner one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that A. B. Norman, F. M. Sparr and D. C. Bennett be and they hereby are appointed viewers and locating surveyors of said road and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 9th day of August A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyors.

In the matter of the petition of Chas. Pilla and others for the establishment of a road

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the South East corner of Section Nineteen (19) Township Nineteen (19) South. Range Twenty (20) East. Thence West on section line between Sections Nineteen (19) and twenty four (24) fourteen (14) and twenty three (23) fifteen (15) and twenty two (22) to the Wakarusa river thence up said river to the Willey crossing of said stream and Charles Pilla one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been
