In the matter of the petition of John P. Brown and others for the establishment of a ^{change of} road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a ^{change of} road as follows. That a change be made in the road established by the board of commissioners on the third day of July A.D. 1867 on the petition of Jacob Weybright and others viz: Beginning at a point in said road at the North East corner of Section twenty six (26) Town Tenth (10) Range Eighteen (18) thence vacate all of said road to a point eighty (80) rods East of said North East corner of Section twenty six (26) and that said road be located as follows beginning at the North East corner of Section twenty six (26) aforesaid thence North about thirty (30) rods thence East about sixty (60) rods. thence South Easterly to a point eighty (80) rods due East of the North East corner of said section twenty six (26) And John P. Brown one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that Henry Nelson & C. M. Metken and J. L. Kelley be and they hereby are appointed viewers and T. L. Darling surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 14th day of August A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk be and he hereby is directed to issue an order in the name of the board to said viewers and surveyor to proceed as required by law to view and locate said road.

In the matter of the petition of James A. Davidson and others for the establishment of a county road.

The said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South East corner of the South West quarter of Section thirty one (31) Town eleven (11) Range eighteen (18) thence running North about one hundred and thirty rods on the line between the S.W. 1/4 and the S.E. 1/4 of Section thirty one (31) Town eleven (11) Range eighteen (18) thence turning Northerly and that on the best ground until it strikes the old travelled road from Lower Bottom, thence North West following the road as near as practicable, until reaching the road in said bottom running East and West. And James A. Davidson one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petition be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of said county, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law.
