In the matter of the petition of Martin Sedgwick and others for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the center of Section Twenty four (24) Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18) Thence North on half Section line one half mile. And Martin Sedgwick one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. And in appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the county of Douglas and that legal notice of the presentation of the petition has been given. It is ordered that Messrs. D. R. Hill and W. B. Jim be and they hereby are appointed viewers and D. L. Darling surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1871 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Robert Fultz and others for the establishment of a road.

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel. It is further ordered that the sum of \$1<sup>00</sup> be allowed to Henry Wittich as compensation and damages being the amount awarded by the viewers.

In the matter of the petition of L. Studitzke and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the viewers with the plat and survey be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.
