

In the matter of the petition of E. D. Load
and others for the establishment of a road

The survey having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objection being made nor damages claimed, the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the survey report with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petition of David Griffith
and others for the establishment of a road

The survey having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objection being made nor damages claimed the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility. It is ordered that the report of the survey with the plat and field notes be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said surveyor and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of Ed. Sperry
and others for the establishment of a road

The survey having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was read and said surveyor having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read. On motion ordered that action on the surveyor's report be postponed until the October meeting of the board.

In the matter of the petition of Charles E. Kauffman
and others for the establishment of a county road

The survey having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and said surveyor having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded land owners by account of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read. And the board being of opinion that the award of said surveyor to wit: To D. Miller \$100. compensation is just, and that said road is of sufficient importance and public utility to warrant the payment of the same out of the county treasury. It is ordered that the county clerk draw a warrant on the county treasury for the sum of One hundred dollars in favor of D. Miller. It is further ordered that the several reports of the survey with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of Henry Bifer
and others for the establishment of a road

The report of the survey having been read at the April meeting of the board and action thereon postponed until the July meeting the report was again read and
