It is further ordered that the Clerk be ordered in the name of the Board to the proper Owner of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of John H. Wells
and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and the viewers having made a separate report in writing in relation to compensation and damages said report was also read and on motion It was ordered that action on said reports be postponed until the October meeting of the Board.

The board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock

The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Grover, Jones and Kitchin and Paul R. Brooks County clerk. The following proceedings were had.

William Means Overseer of Poor of Mahanood Township presented his report of receipts and disbursements as such Overseer which was examined with vouchers presented and approved.

J. D. Starn Overseer of Poor of Palmyra Township presented his report of receipts and disbursements as such Overseer for the year ending July first 1871 which was examined with vouchers and approved.

A petition was presented signed by Eleonora Ross asking that compensation and damages be allowed her for land taken for road established on petition of C. O. Emery and others. Ordered that the petition be dismissed without further proceedings.

Ordered that the county attorney be and he hereby is instructed to take the necessary measures to recover from the Seaboard Commerce and Belvidere Rail road Company the three hundred thousand dollars of the stock of said Company subscribed by the county of Douglas and paid for by said county with the bonds of the county and which stock was obtained by said company without consideration and further that the county be instructed if said stock is not returned to the county at his request to immediately commence suit in the proper court to recover the said stock or its value in money.
