On application of D. F. Starr Overseer of Poor of Palmyra township
Ordered that the sum of One hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the county general fund for temporary support of poor in Palmyra Township and that the county clerk issue an order on the treasurer payable to said Overseer of Poor.

On application of William Meier Overseer of poor in Wakarusa township
Ordered that the sum of Fifty Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the county general fund for the support of poor in Wakarusa township and that the county clerk issue an order on the county treasurer for the said amount payable to said Overseer of poor of Wakarusa township.

On application of R. M. Service Superintendent of County Asylum
Ordered that the sum of One hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the county general fund for hired help on poor farm and that the sum of twenty dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the county general fund for repairing cabin on poor farm and that the county clerk issue warrants on the treasurer for said amounts payable to the Supt. of County Asylum.

The bill of Simmons and Adams for work and material at County jail amounting to \$537.75 was laid over until July 18th 1871.

The bill of Henry F. Russell for illegal tax paid amounting to \$20.50. was rejected.

The bill of Wm B. Saul for illegal tax paid amounting to \$8.30 was rejected.

The bills of J. A. Barker M.D. for professional services on coroner's inquest. L. A. Pearse constructing bridges. W. M. McNeill for services at Post mortem examination coroner's inquest. Arch. Mosher for illegal tax paid. Alex. Thompson services Post mortem examination. Pith Reed illegal tax paid. A. Newman services at Post mortem examination coroner's inquest and James Shields for illegal tax paid were laid over for further examination.
