Lawrence Kansas July 26th 1871

The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment there were present commissioners Brown, Jones and Reinshorn and the county clerk Paul R. Brock. The following proceedings were had.

Mr. J. Beach County Treasurer presented a report of the receipts and disbursements of the County Treasury from July 13th 1870 until July 12th 1871 which was examined with vouchers presented. On motion Ordered that the report be accepted and adopted and that the same be filed in the clerk's office.

Ordered that the county treasurer do and he hereby is instructed to prepare and present to the board at its next meeting a supplementary report showing the amount in the Treasury on the 12th day of July A.D. 1871 belonging to the different funds and to the several corporations for whom taxes are collected by the County.

Ordered that the county clerk do and he hereby is instructed to prepare a report of the receipts and expenditures of the county for the year ending July 12 1871 and have the same
