The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Grover, Jones and Kinslow and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

Ordered by the board that the action heretofore brought by the County Attorney on behalf of the board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas against the Beavercreek, Lawrence and Galveston Railroad Company to recover the three hundred thousand dollars of Douglas County bonds delivered to them by Geo. Luttig, G. W. E. Griffith and Aaron E. Platts former County Commissioners of Douglas County on or about the 9th July A.D. 1869 on the value or amount thereof in money is hereby approved of by this board and the said county attorney is hereby ordered to prosecute said action as expeditiously as practicable to a final result.

Ordered that a tax of one fourth of one per cent be levied on all the taxable property of the township of Eudora for the purpose of paying interest on bonds to be issued to the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver R. R. Co and to create a sinking fund for the final payment of said bonds.

The board adjourned
