

Appurtenances of a permanent depot upon the present town site of Leocompton and also a station of like character in Big Springs Precinct in said township of Leocompton.

Fifth The said rail road must be fully completed as aforesaid, and through trains operated thereon as aforesaid on or before the 31st day of December AD 1872.

Ballots to be printed or written "For the subscription of stock in the Lawrence and Topeka Railway" or "Against the subscription of stock in the Lawrence and Topeka railway" &c.

It is further Ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to cause to be published in the name of the board notice of the election hereby called, in the Weekly Home Journal and the daily republican journal as required by law.

A petition was presented signed by Elijah Sells and others asking the board to submit to the qualified electors of the county a proposition authorizing the county board to appropriate money to purchase a fair ground for the use of the Douglas County Agricultural Society.

Ordered that a proposition be submitted to the qualified electors of the county at the general election to be held on the seventh day of November next to authorize the County Commissioners of the county of Douglas to appropriate money for the purchase of suitable ground for the use of the Douglas County Agricultural Society not exceeding in amount one and a half mills on the valuation of the taxable property of the county and if necessary to levy a tax for such purpose - It is further Ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to cause notice of the submission of said proposition to be published in the name of the board.

Ordered that George Wood be and he is hereby appointed Clerk of Clinton Township to fill vacancy occasioned by the removal of M. J. Paynes late Township clerk from the Township.

Ordered that the sum of One hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general fund for the support of poor in Palmyra township and that the County Clerk issue an Order on the County Treasurer for the amount payable to the Overseer of Poor of said Township.
