The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners Joel Grover (chairman of the board) Joseph L. Jones and Newton Henshaw, and Paul R. Brooks county clerk. The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the location of a
State road from Atchison to Lawrence

The commissioners appointed under an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas to locate a state road from Atchison to Lawrence having filed their report in the county clerk's office it was this day publicly read and no damages being claimed it is ordered that the report of the commissioners, together with the plat and survey be recorded, and that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board, to the proper Officers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of M. S.
Beach and others for a road begin-
ning at the S. E. corner of the N. W.
1/4 of Section 25 Town 12 Range 19

The viewer having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and said viewer having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to the several land owners through whose premises said road is located said report was also read. And the board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by said viewer to wit: To A. M. Wilder One dollar, is reasonable and just and that said road will be of public utility and no legal objections being made. It is ordered that the several reports of the viewer with the survey and plat of the road be recorded, and that said road be and the same is hereby established. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to the proper Officers of roads directing him or them to cause said road to be opened according to law.
