

In the matter of the petition of John R. Wells and others for the establishment of a road beginning at a point where the Lawrence and Topeka road intersects the line between Sections 13 & 14 Town 12 Range 17.

The report of the viewers having been considered at the July session of the board and laid over. The report was again read, and said viewers having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to the several land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises, said report was also read, and the board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by said viewers to wit: To O. C. Wilson compensation fifteen dollars. To Anthony Wells twenty five dollars compensation, is reasonable and just that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation out of the county treasury, and no objections being made. It is Ordered that the county clerk draw orders on the county treasurer for the amount so awarded, in favor of the several claimants. That the several reports of the viewers, with the survey and plat of said road, be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered, that the county clerk issue in the name of the board, an Order to the proper Overseer or Overseers of roads, to cause said road to be opened according to law.

In the matter of the petition of Martin Sedgwick and others for the establishment of a road beginning at the center of Section Twenty four Township 12 Range 18

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road. The report was this day publicly read. and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded to the several land owners through whose premises said road is located, said report was also read. and the board being of opinion that the award of said viewers to wit: To William Persons twenty dollars compensation and thirty dollars damages. To C. F. Perkins, thirty Dollars (\$30) compensation
