That said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the County treasury, no legal objections being made it is ordered that the county clerk draw orders on the County treasurer for the amount so awarded. That the several reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseer or Overseers of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

In the matter of the petition of William Millner and others for the establishment of a road, beginning at the N.E. corner of Section eight, (8) Township, (12) Range 20.

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read. and said viewers having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to the several land owners through whose premises said road is located. said report was also read and the board being of opinion that the award of said viewers to wit: To A.S. Phillips and Alice Litchfield, fifty dollars compensation for land and fifty dollars damages. is reasonable and just. That said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of county treasury, no legal objection being made it is Ordered that the county clerk issue an order on the county treasurer for the amount so awarded in favor of said A.S. Phillips and Litchfield. That the several reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper Overseer or Overseers of roads to cause said road to be opened according to law
