

having made a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to the several land owners through whose premises said road is located said report was also read, and the board being of opinion that the award of said views to the several claimants to wit: To J. P. Hubbard One dollar compensation for land. To N. N. Osburn One dollar compensation for land is reasonable and just that said road will be of public utility. no legal objections being made It is ordered that the county clerk issue orders on the county treasurer for the amounts so awarded. that the several reports with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board to the proper officers of roads directing him or them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of H. M. Simpson and others for a road

The views having filed their reports it was read. Ordered that the consideration of the report be postponed until some future meeting of the board.

In the matter of the petition of Charles W. Mitchell and others for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the North East corner of the North West quarter of Section twenty two (22) Town Twelve (12) range thirteen (13) thence South on or near the half section line to the South East corner of the South West quarter of Section twenty seven (27) of said town and range, and Charles W. Mitchell one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of the costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that the notice of presentation of the petition has been given according to law.
