

the work according to the plans and specifications prepared by J. H. Haskell to awarded to said J. M. Chamberlain at Twenty two hundred and fifty dollars.

Ordered that the county clerk sign a contract in accordance with the plans and specifications and terms of the bid of J. M. Chamberlain to be signed by said Chamberlain and the chairman of the board.

Ordered that the contractor be required to furnish a bond with approved security conditioned for the faithful performance and completion of the work according to the contract.

Ordered that the sum of Two hundred and ninety five Dollars and forty cents be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general county fund for the purpose of building a bridge over Coal creek north of St. B. Townships that the sum of One hundred and twenty nine dollars and sixty cents be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of grading on Lawrence and Prairie City road north of Cottontown and that the sum of Seventy five Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of building a bridge East of Baldwin city. It is further Ordered that the said appropriations amounting in all to five hundred dollars be expended under the direction of J. F. Starr Trustee of Palmyra Township. and that the county clerk issue an order on the county treasurer for the sum of five hundred dollars payable to the trustee of Palmyra Township.

The board adjourned until November tenth a.d. 1871
