

hundred and thirty five of the qualified voters of said township of Seecompton voted in favor of such subscription and issuance of bonds as aforesaid and only twenty five of the qualified voters of said township voted against said proposition as appears from the official returns of said election duly canvassed and on file in the County Clerk's Office of said County, and it appearing that One hundred and thirty five qualified voters of said township, voting in favor of said proposition are more than three fifths of the qualified electors of said township voting at such election It is therefore Ordered by the board of county commissioners, that the County Clerk of the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas do make for and in the name of said township of Seecompton the said subscription of twenty thousand dollars to the Capital stock of the said Lawrence and Topeka Railway Company according to the terms and conditions of the said order submitting the said proposition to the qualified electors of said township and the said County Clerk is hereby directed to spread the said subscription on the record of proceedings of the County board of county commissioners of said County and to deliver the original subscription to the Lawrence and Topeka Rail way Company—
Subscription.

Whereas on the 2^d day of October A.D. 1871 The board of, County Commissioners of the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas made an official order Submitting to the qualified electors of the township of Seecompton in said County a proposition in the words and figures as follows to wit: Shall the township of Seecompton be authorized to take stock in the name of said township, in the Lawrence and Topeka Rail way company, to the amount of Twenty thousand dollars, said bonds payable thirty years from the date of issue in the City of New York, with interest coupons attached at the rate of seven per cent per annum payable semi annually. provided that no bonds shall be issued until each and every one of the following conditions shall first be fully fulfilled performed and completed by the said Lawrence and Topeka Rail way company
First The said Lawrence and Topeka Rail way company shall build and fully complete a rail road from the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas to the West line of the said township of Seecompton on the south side of the Kansas river Second, the said
