There were present commissioners Grover, Jones and Hirschaw and Paul R. Brooks County clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

Ordered that the county clerk do and he is hereby instructed to procure suitable blank bonds and munici and prepare the same to the amount of fifteen thousand dollars for the township of Eudora, to be used to the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Railroad company in accordance with the vote of said township on the

day of A.D. 1871 and the law in such cases made and provided. It is further Ordered that the chairman of the board and the county clerk do and they are hereby instructed to sign said bonds and deliver the same to said Saint Louis Lawrence and Denver Railroad company or its authorized agent upon the completion of the road as provided in the proposition voted upon by said township to take stock and issue bonds.
