Said petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the North East corner of the North West quarter of section four, (4) township fifteen (15) range twenty (20) Thence East on township line, dividing townships fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) ranges twenty (20) and twenty one (21), to the East line of Douglas county, and St. H. Jenkins, one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas county, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given, as required by law. It is Ordered that J. I. Starr, Henry Metter and James Skaggs, three disinterested house holders of Douglas county do and they hereby are, appointed viewers and H. Darling Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 29th day of January ad 1872 and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk give in the name of the board an order to said viewers and surveyors to view and survey said road as required by law.
