

In the matter of the petition of J. C.
Moore and others for change in State
road from Clinton to Poplar

The petitioners having made
application for the alteration of said road as follows.

We the undersigned home holders of Clinton and Hamwaka Townships
Douglas County Kansas, and in the vicinity of the road hereafter
mentioned do respectfully petition you to change the state road
from Clinton to Poplar. at the point where said road leaves
the half section line on section seventeen (17) Township Thirtieth
(33) range Eighteen (18) so as to make it leave said line twenty
(20) rods from the North East corner of the South West
quarter of said section and run South forty (40) feet thence
West two hundred (200) feet. Thence North West to said line.

thence West on said line to the North West corner of the South
West quarter of said section. thence South to said Clinton
and Poplar road. and J. C. Moore one of the petitioners
having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars
payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of
Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses
accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the peti-
tioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved.

And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve
house holders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the
presentation has been given as required by law. It is Ordered
that E. Disbrow, M. Allen and Horace Tucker, three dis-
interested home holders of said county be and they hereby are
appointed viewers and P. C. Darling Surveyor of said road. and
that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of as-
signing designated in said petition on the 21st day of
February ad 1892 and after being duly sworn proceed to the
discharge of the duties of their respective appointments according
to law. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue in
the name of the board the necessary Orders to said viewers
and Surveyor.

In the matter of the Appropriation of
Two hundred dollars for the purpose
of opening the Clinton & Seecompton road
