In the matter of the petition of James C. Wilson for licence to keep a Ferry

Said James C. Wilson having made application for licence to keep a Ferry on the Kansas river at the city of Sawnee and the board being satisfied that said ferry is necessary for the accommodation of the public It is ordered that the county clerk issue a licence to said James C. Wilson to keep a ferry at the city of Sawnee for one year from the 5th day of January A.D. 1872 upon his filing a bond with approved security as required by law.

Ordered that the rates of ferryage for the ferry across the Kansas river at Sawnee be fixed as follows.

One or two horse teams	five cents
Woman and round trip	five cents
Footman	Three
