

Sawnee, Kansas January 5 1872

The board of county commissioners met pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners Joel Groce J. L. Jones and Weston Hinshaw and Paul R. Brooks county clerk. The following proceedings were had.

The board proceeded to examine the record of Estrays, and it appearing that there are several cases where from the lapse of time the stock posted has become the property of the taker up and that the moiety due the county has not been paid. It is Ordered that the county clerk issue Warrants in the name of the board, and under the seal of the county in all cases where from the lapse of time the stock has become the property of the taker up and the moiety not paid into the county treasury directed to the sheriff of the county, commanding him to collect the amounts due the county according to law.

Ordered that the county treasurer do and he is hereby instructed to withhold payment of the interest on the three hundred thousand dollars of bonds of the county issued to the Seawayworth Sawnee and Galveston Railroad company for the year ad. 1871 which became due on the first day of January ad. 1872 until the further order of the board.

It is further Ordered that the county clerk make a certified copy of this order and deliver the same to the county treasurer.

Ordered that the sum of One hundred dollars do and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general county fund to the Chairman of the board for extra services as chairman of the board for the past year and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to draw an order on the County Treasurer for said amount payable to Joel Groce Chairman.

Ordered that J. C. Vincent late trustee of Sawnee Township do and he is hereby directed to pay into the county treasury the balance of appropriation in his hands as shown by said Vincent's report to this board. Ordered that the county clerk furnish Mr Vincent with a copy of the foregoing order.

The county clerk presented county orders on the treasurer that had remained unclaimed for three years to the amount of One hundred and twenty three dollars and ninety cents, a list of which was made and filed in the county clerk's office, and it is Ordered that the county clerk cancel said orders on the
