Distrow Commissioners and the county clerk Paul R. Brooks. On motion of Commissioner Grover O. Darling was duly elected Chairman of the board.

The following proceedings were had

Ordered that E. Distrow be and he is hereby appointed Trustee of Clinton Township to fill the vacancy occasioned by the acceptance of the office of ^{acting commissioner by} W. B. Distrow late Trustee.

W. B. Distrow late trustee of Clinton township presented his report as such trustee which was examined with his vouchers and approved.

W. B. Distrow late Overseer of poor of Clinton township presented his report of appropriation made for support of poor in said township showing balance in his hands of five and 45/100 dollars.

A petition was presented and read signed by W. Hadley and others asking the board to rescind the order made to the County Treasurer instructing him to withhold the payment of the interest on the bonds issued by the county to the Government.
