

the Farmers Loan and Trust company of New York, to be by it issued and delivered upon the certificate of the board that all the terms of said proclamation promulgated to which an election was held at which the board was authorized to make the subscription and issue said bonds have been complied with and that Two hundred thousand dollars of the full paid stock of said Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Railroad company have been issued to the county of Douglas, but this subscription is upon condition that said road from Lawrence to Carbondale shall always be operated as a main line, and that if at any time the said road from Lawrence to Carbondale shall cease to be run and operated as the main line of said company, the said Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Railroad company shall thereafter be indebted to said county of Douglas in the sum of Two hundred thousand dollars and which shall be a first lien on said road in advance of any mortgage said road to be of the same grade as the road from Lawrence to Pleasant Hill.

Ordered that that the clerk prepare bonds to to the amount of Two hundred thousand dollars in denominations of One thousand dollars, with interest coupons attached at the rate of seven per cent per annum payable semi annually and that the chairman of the board and county clerk execute and sign said bonds and deposit the same in escrow with the Farmers Loan and Trust company of New York to be delivered only upon the certificate of the county commissioners of the county of Douglas that the terms of the subscription of stock and the proclamation under which the election authorizing said subscription of stock, was held, have been fully complied with.

The bill of C. A. Pease for Stove and Hardware amounting to \$67.80 was examined and allowed. The bill of K. M. Hulke for making map of city of Lawrence for Clerk's office amounting to \$54.00 was examined and allowed.

The board adjourned until March 2^d 1872
