The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows commencing at the South East corner of Section twentyone (21) Township twelve (12) range twenty (20) thence running West to the Southwly bounds of the right of way of the Kansas Pacific Rail way company, thence in a South Westerly direction along the South bounds of said rail ways right of way to the West line of Section twenty eight (28) thence South to the half section line of said section being one half mile thence West to East street in the city of Lawrence and J. H. Haight one of the petitioners, having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve freeholders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law It is ordered that A. E. Morgan J. B. Young and William Stone three disinterested freeholders of the county of Douglas be and they are hereby appointed viewers and S. C. Darling surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 9th day of May ad 1872 at an o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the county clerk issue an order in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.
