

In the matter of the petition of
Carrington Bohne and others for
the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South East corner of the South East quarter of Section sixteen (16) town twelve (12) range eighteen (18) thence East on line or as near as practicable to intersect the Lawrence and Leecompton Middle road at the South East corner of the South West quarter of Section eighteen (18) town twelve (12) range nineteen (19). And Carrington Bohne one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice and publication of the presentation of the petition has been made as required by law. It is ordered that John H. Williams, J. C. Furman and H. Snicker three disinterested householders of the County of Douglas, be and they are hereby appointed viewers and F. C. Darling Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyors meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 14th day of May 1872 at ten o'clock a.m. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue an Order in the name of the board to said viewers and surveyor to view and survey said road as required by law.

In the matter of the petition of
Charles Pilla and others for the
establishment of a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the corner to sections seven (7) eight (8) seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) town thirteen (13) range twenty one (21) thence West on Section line to intersect road at or near Blue-jackets Crossing of the Wakarusa river. and Charles Pilla one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas
