The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Darling, Grover and Distrow and Paul R. Brooks county clerk.

The following proceedings were had

Ordered that Joel Grover be and he is hereby appointed the agent of the county of Douglas to represent the county in any stockholders meeting of the Saint Louis Lawrence and Denver Railroad Company and to vote the stock of the county at any such meeting.

Ordered that hereafter this board will allow bills for services on the board of examiners for not to exceed twelve days in each year.

The Trustees of Nakornna, Secompton, Harward, Clinton, Marion, Palmyra and Eudora Townships presented their reports of official transactions of the township for the past year said reports were examined with vouchers and the reports were approved.

In the matter of the subscription of stock in the Saint Louis Lawrence and Denver
