

Rail road company by
The Township of Clinton

Whereas this board did on the 12th day of July A.D. 1871 and pursuant to the petition of more than fifty (50) qualified voters and free-holders of the Township of Clinton in said county make an official Order, submitting to the qualified voters of said township a proposition to subscribe for and take stock in the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Rail road company to the amount of twenty five thousand dollars, and the issuance of twenty five thousand dollars of the bonds of said township to the said Saint Louis, Lawrence, and Denver Rail road company in payment of said stock at par and whereas said Order provided for such submission to the voters of said township on the fifteenthth day of August A.D. 1871, and whereas at such election One hundred and twenty five (125) voters of said township of Clinton voted in favor of such subscription and issue of bonds as aforesaid and only forty nine (49) of the qualified voters of said township voted against said proposition, as appears from the official returns of said election duly canvassed and on file in the county clerk's office of said county and it appearing that more than three fifths of the qualified electors of said township voting at said election, voted in favor of said bonds. It is therefore Ordered by the board that the county clerk do make for and in the name of the township of Clinton the said subscription of twenty five thousand dollars to the capital stock of the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Rail road company according to the terms and conditions of said Order, submitting said proposition to the voters of said township.

Ordered that the county clerk do and he is hereby directed to advertise for proposals for doing the county printing and advertising for one year from the first day of May next. Proposals to be received until the 9th instant.
