Lawrence Kansas April 9 1872

The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment there were present commissioners Darling, Grover and Disbrow and the County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the petition of
Larnie Sims and others for review
and reestablishment of a state road

The reviewers appointed
to review the location of the Sopris and Clinton
State road located in Douglas county having filed
their report, it was read and Ordered by the board
that the report, plat and survey be recorded as
required by law.

The board proceeded to open proposals for doing
the printing and advertising of the county for one
year from the first day of May ad 1872 and the
board being satisfied that the bid of T. Dwight
Thacher is the lowest and best bid. It is Ordered
that the contract for doing the county printing for
one year from the first day of May ad 1872 be and
the same is hereby awarded to T. Dwight Thacher
at the following rates viz: Job Printing free.
The county to furnish the paper. Advertising Tax
List at one half legal rates. All other advertisements
at legal rates.

Ordered that the county clerk
do and he is hereby instructed to advertise for
proposals to be received at his office until
