The board of commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, there were present O. Darling, Joel Grover, and E. Disbrow, and the county clerk Paul R. Brooks.

In the matter of the petition of J. M. Shepherd and others for the alteration of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said change of road the report was this day publicly read, and said viewers having filed a separate report in certifying of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them to the several land owners through whose premises said road is located, said report was also read, and the board being of opinion that the award of said viewers, to wit: To Simpson Hollister thirty five dollars compensation for land, and sixty five dollars damages is reasonable and just: That said road will be of public utility and sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the county treasury, It is ordered, that the county clerk draw orders upon the county treasurer for the amount of said award, in favor of Simpson Hollister, That the several reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said change of road be recorded, and that said change of road be established. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue an Order in the name of the board to the proper Officer of roads directing him to cause
