The board proceeded to open bids for furnishing medical attendance at County Asylum and jail, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that the bid of Hilder and Morse is the lowest responsible bid. It is Ordered that the contract for furnishing medical attendance at the County Asylum and jail to and the same is hereby awarded to Hilder and Morse according to the terms of their bid viz: Two Dollars per visit at County Asylum, and twenty five cents at jail.

Ordered that the Chairman of the board and County Clerk be and they are hereby appointed authorized and empowered to make, execute and deliver on behalf of the County of Douglas a Quit-claim deed to the City of Lawrence in said County of Douglas, conveying to said City of Lawrence all the right, title, claim and interest in and to that certain tract or parcel of land lying on the South of the Kansas river East of Massachusetts Street and West of the East line of New York Street, in said City of Lawrence and designated in the recorded plat of said City as "Level" for such considerations as in their judgment may be adequate therefor.

Ordered that the Chairman of the board be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to confer with the proper authorities of the City of Lawrence in relation to the sidewalk taxes certified to the County Clerk and placed on the tax rolls and which have been decided by the District Court to be illegal.

Ordered that the sum of One Hundred Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general County fund for the support of poor in Palmyra township, and that the Clerk make an order on the County Treasurer for the amount payable to the Owner of poor of said township.

Ordered that the right of way be and the same is hereby granted to the Lawrence and Topeka Railway company over the lot of ground owned by the County on which the County jail is located.
